



TT Practice & Race Week 2024 Service Revisions



Details of bus service alterations during road closures for the TT Practices and Races are shown below.

Daytime Practice: Monday 27 May - Roads closed from **1000** to no later than **2130**
Friday 31 May - Roads closed from **1230** to no later than **1630**

Evening Practice: Tuesday 28 May to Thursday 30 May
Roads closed between **1800** to no later than **2130**.

Race Days: Saturday 1 June - Roads closed from **1000** until racing is finished.
Sunday 2 June Roads closed from **1230** until racing is finished (no later than **1830**).
Tuesday 4 and Wednesday 5 June - Roads closed from **1000** until racing is finished
Friday 7 and Saturday 8 June - Roads closed from **1000** until racing is finished

Unless specifically marked the TT course can remain closed until no later than **2130**.

Between Monday 3 June and Thursday 6 June (inclusive) the TT Course must be open between 1700 & 1800 (this does not include the A18 Mountain Road)

Departures from Banks Circus, Douglas

During TT 2024 scheduled departures from Banks Circus may not be possible. Anyone who normally boards their bus at Banks Circus is advised to travel to either Lord Street or Loch Promenade by any departure from Banks Circus.

Ramsey Departure Point

During TT 2024 all bus departures during TT Course closures are from the vacant site on Albert Road opposite Ramsey Bus Station.

Wildlife Park

From Friday 24 May until Monday 10 June buses **do not** serve the bus shelter in the Wildlife Park

Buses travelling toward Ramsey stop at the car park entrance.

Buses traveling toward Kirk Michael for Peel **DO NOT** stop at the wildlife Park during this period.

Strang

Between Friday 31 May and Saturday 8 June when the enhanced TT Service is in operation,

Service 5/5c journeys between Peel and Douglas DO NOT serve Strang Road or Strang crossroads between **0900 & 1800**. For travel from Strang to Douglas a temporary stop is located on Nobles Hospital South Drive close to the Cronk Griannagh junction.

Peel Promenade

Due to additional traffic during the T.T. period buses do not serve the Peel Quayside and Promenade stops between **Saturday 25 May and Sunday 9 June** (inclusive).

Service **5/5c/6/6a/6c** journeys operate from Tynwald Road via Albany Road to the Peel Town Hall stop.

Service **5** journeys then depart at the scheduled Peel Town Hall departure time.

Service **6/6a** journeys to Ballawattleworth depart Peel Town Hall 1 minute after the House of Manannan time to Peveril Road and Ballawattleworth.

During the period **Friday 31 May to Saturday 8 June** the enhanced Service 5/6/6a/6c timetable operates with resultant route variations.

 - Service 12/12a depart Birch Hill at 0948, 1048, 1148 and then 38 & 58 minutes past each hour from 1238.
 - Service 11/11a journeys between St Ninians and Lord Street are replaced by Service 22v.
 - Service 12 via Bucks Road is replaced between Lord Street and St Ninians by Service 22v.
- The departures from Birch Hill at 38 & 58 minutes past each hour still provide connections at Lord Street for journeys to Ronaldsway Airport, Castletown and Port Erin.

Friday 31 May - Daytime Practice Day - 1230 road closure:

- Service 2 & 2a operate to & from Ballachrink as timetabled.
 - Service 11/11a operate to Birch Hill at 20 & 40 from Loch Promenade as timetabled.
 - Service 12 journeys depart Birch Hill at 38 & 58 minutes past each hour.
 - Service 11/11a journeys between St Ninians and Lord Street are replaced by Service 22v.
 - Service 12 via Bucks Road is replaced between Lord Street and St Ninians by Service 22v.
- The departures from Birch Hill at 38 & 58 minutes past each hour still provide connections at Lord Street for journeys to Ronaldsway Airport, Castletown and Port Erin.

Race Days:

- On all race days Service 11/11a journeys between St Ninians and Lord Street are replaced by Service 22v
 - Service 12 via Bucks Road is replaced between Lord Street and St Ninians by Service 22v
 - Service 2 & 2a operate to & from Ballachrink as timetabled.
 - Service 11/11a operate to Birch Hill at 20 & 40 from Loch Promenade as timetabled.
 - Service 12 journeys depart Birch Hill at 38 & 58 minutes past each hour.
 - Service 11/11a journeys between St Ninians and Lord Street are replaced by Service 22v.
 - Service 12 via Bucks Road is replaced between Lord Street and St Ninians by Service 22v.
- The departures from Birch Hill at 38 & 58 minutes past each hour still provide connections at Lord Street for journeys to Ronaldsway Airport, Castletown and Port Erin.

Service 3 & 3a

Evening Practice Nights - 1800 closure:

- The 1740, 1810, 1840, 1910, 1940 & 2010 Service 3/3a departures from Douglas (Lord Street) divert from Woodbourne Road via Derby Road, Broadway and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms. Upper Woodbourne Road and York Road are served by Service 22v journeys.
- The 1740, 1810, 1840, 1910 & 1940 departures from Ramsey divert from the Manx Arms via Summer Hill and Promenades to Lord Street.

Daytime Practice Day - 1000 closure:

- Commencing with the 1010 journey all Service 3/3a departures from Douglas (Lord Street) divert from Woodbourne Road via Derby Road, Broadway and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms until the TT Course has re-opened. Upper Woodbourne Road and York Road are served by Service 22v journeys.
- Commencing with the 1010 journey all Service 3/3a departures from Ramsey divert from the Manx Arms via Summer Hill and Promenades to Lord Street until the TT Course has re-opened.

- Street.

Race Days:

- Commencing with the first departure from Douglas (Lord Street) to Ramsey less than 30 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Ridgeway Street via Victoria Street, Promenads and Summerhill Road to the Manx Arms - therefore not serving Bucks Road, Rosemount or Woodbourne Road.
- Commencing with the first departure from Onchan to Lower Douglas less than 20 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Whitebridge Road via Royal Avenue, Port Jack and the Promenades to Lord Street.

During the period of enhanced school holidays and Saturdays service increases the number of buses travelling via Glencrutchery Road (to serve the TT Grandstand area) with the 1740, 1840 & 1940 departures from Lord Street and the 1640, 1740 & 1840 departures from Ramsey operating as Service 3 and not 3a.

During the Enhanced TT timetable an

Service X3

- During the period Friday 26 May to Thursday 8 June all **Service X3** journeys operate via the Coast Road without pick up/set down.
- Due to operational needs, between Tuesday 30 May and Thursday 8 June the evening Service X3 departures from Douglas, Lord Street at 1706 & 1736 may operate as normal Service 3 (on nights when the TT Course closes at 1800 the 1736 journey diverts from Derby Road via the Promenade and Summer Hill).
- **Bank Holiday:** On Monday 29 May and Friday 9 June the Service X3 does not operate.

Service 4/ 4b/ 4n/ 14 & 14b

Evening Practices: Tuesday 28, Wednesday 29 and Thursday 30 May

- The 1748 Service 4b departure from Douglas diverts from Circular Road via Peel Road and Groves Road to New Castletown Road - therefore **NOT** serving Westmoreland Road, Mount Bradda, Selbourne Road and Alexander Drive.
- The 1713 & 1807 Service 4 departures from Peel divert via Groves Road.

Daytime Practice: Friday 31 May

- Service 4/4b: The 1315 & 1515 departures from Douglas and 1410 & 1613 departures from Peel are cancelled.
The 1215 14b departure from Douglas diverts from Circular Road via Peel Road and Groves Road to Saddle Road.
The 1208 & 1408 departures from Peel divert from the IOM Business Park via Cooil Road, Spring Valley, Groves Road and Peel Road to Circular Road.
- The 1355 14b departure from Douglas diverts from Circular Road via Peel Road and Groves Road to Saddle Road - diverting on return from Cooil Road via Groves Road and Peel Road to Circular Road.

Race Days Saturdays 1 & 8 June:

- The 0715, 1615 and 1745 departures from Douglas and the 0800 and 1713 departures from Peel operate as timetabled (with the diversions shown above if required).
- The 1115 & 1515 departures from Douglas and 1213 & 1613 departures from Peel and cancelled.

Race Days Sunday 4 June and Bank Holiday Friday 9 June:

- The Bank Holiday journeys (0800 from Peel and 1745 from Douglas) operate.

Race Days - Monday 5 June to Thursday 8 June (includes contingency days):

- The Service 4b departures from Douglas at 0915, 1115 & 1315 and departures from Peel at 1008, 1208 & 1408 are cancelled.
- The 1515 service 4b diverts from Lord Street via White Hoe & Cooil Road to IOM Business park then as timetabled
- Service 14b: The 1015, 1215 and 1345 departures from Douglas divert from Circular Road via Peel Road and Groves Road to Saddle Road - diverting on return from Cooil Road via Groves Road and Peel Road to Circular Road.
- The Service 4n journeys operate as per timetable
- The Service 14 (Tuesday & Thursday) departures from Douglas at 1155 & 1455 operate as timetabled. The Castletown departures at 1243 and 1543 divert from IOM Business Park via Cooil Road, Groves Road and Peel Road to Circular Road.

Service 15/15B

Daytime Race Days

- Service 15 journeys departing Douglas divert from Ballaquayle Road via Broadway and Promenades to Summerhill Road. Journeys departing Onchan divert from Summerhill via Promenades, Broadway and Derby Road to Woodbourne Road.
- Service 15B journeys operate as timetabled.

Service 5/ 5a/ 5c/ 6/ 6a/ 6c

Evening Practice and Daytime Practice/ Race Days:

- Commencing with the first departure from Douglas (Lord Street) to Peel less than 40 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from Douglas via Foxdale to St Johns and Peel until the roads re-open.
- Commencing with the first departure from Peel to Douglas less than 40 minutes before the roads are due to close, buses divert from St Johns via Foxdale to Douglas until the roads re-open.
- Diverted services operate from Castletown Road via Springfield and Alder Road to Groves Road
- Service 5 journeys departing Douglas within 60 minutes of road closure serve Nobles Hospital but **DO NOT** serve Strang.
Service 5 journeys departing Douglas within 40 minutes of road closure **DO NOT** serve Strang or Nobles Hospital .
- Commencing with the first departure from either Peel to Ramsey or Ramsey to Peel less than 35 minutes before the roads are due to close all services are cancelled until the roads re-open.
- The 1707 Service 5 is the last guaranteed journey to serve Crosby - Greeba - Ballacraigne before roads close.
- The 1722 service 5a operates diverts from Glen Darragh Road
- When roads are due to close at 1800 the 1737 service 6c does not operate.

Service 21/ 21b/ 21h

Evening Practice Nights and Sunday/Bank Holiday Daytime Closures:

- During the closure of the TT Course the Service 21H departures from Lower Douglas operate as far as the Meadow Crescent roundabout - departing from the Heather View stop on Vicarage Road at the scheduled time.

Race Days:

- If there is severe congestion on New Castletown Road or Pulrose Bridge when the TT Course is closed then journeys departing Anagh Coar are subject to diversion via Kewaigue and White Hoe to Lord Street (with diverted Service 5/6 journeys serving the Alder Road stop).

Service 22/ 22h/ 25 & 25h

Evening Practice and Daytime Practice/ Race Days:

- Commencing with first departures from Douglas (Lord Street) less than 35 minutes before the roads are due to close, **Service 22/ 22h, 25 & 25h** between Lower Douglas and Willaston are replaced by **Service 22v** which operates via Bucks Road, Somerset Road to St Ninians then Ballaquayle Road to Victoria Road (Shoprite) - then returning via York Road, Woodbourne Road and Bucks Road to Lower Douglas.
- When the roads are closed the Service 22v replaces Services 11 & 12 along Woodbourne Road and continues until the roads re-open.
- Inside the TT Course **Service 22k** operates between St Ninians, Willaston and Nobles Hospital until the roads re-open.
- For full details of Services 22k & 22v please see the timetables below.

In the event of **delays on Race Days** the pattern of operation for the evening practice nights is followed.

On delayed Race Days when the TT Course re-opens between 1700 and 1800 buses continue to follow the diversion routes with the exception of the journeys below which can safely use the TT Course while it is open to normal traffic.

1706 Service X3 departure from Douglas, Lord Street - via Rosemount and Victoria Road.

1710 Service 3 departure from Douglas, Lord Street - via Rosemount and Glencrutchery Road.

1707 Service 5 departure from Douglas, Lord Street - (serving Nobles Hospital but NOT Strang) operating to Peel Town Hall and Ballawattleworth only.

The 1722 Service 5a departure from Douglas, Lord Street.

The 1645 Service 5c (enhanced timetable) departure from Ramsey to Peel.

The 1650 Service 5c departure from Peel to Ramsey (1607 from Douglas via Foxdale).
